## The Importance of Mammograms

Annual mammograms can detect cancer early — when it is most treatable. In fact, mammograms show changes in the breast up to two years before a patient or physician can feel them. Mammograms can also prevent the need for extensive treatment for advanced cancers and improve chances of breast conservation. Current guidelines from the American College of Radiology and the American Cancer Society recommend that women receive annual mammograms starting at age 40 — even if they have no symptoms or family history of breast cancer.

## Screening Mammograms

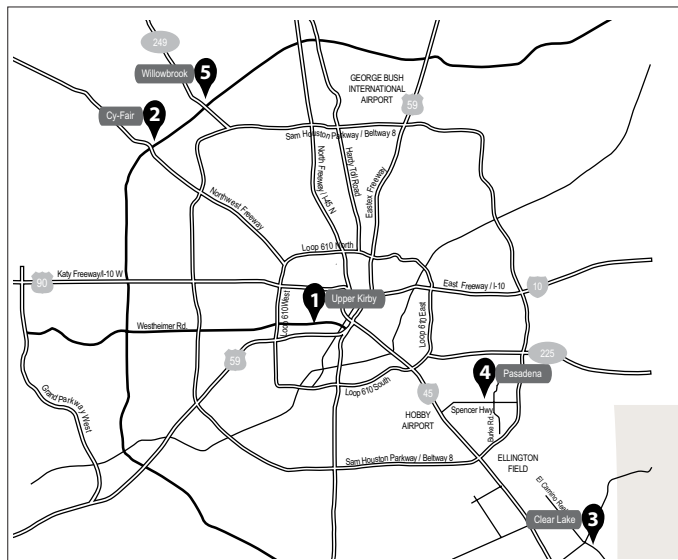
A screening mammogram is a routine X-ray exam of the breast used to screen for breast problems, such as a lump.

A diagnostic mammogram is used to evaluate abnormalities detected on a screening mammogram or because of special circumstances.

## 3D Mammograms

Breast tomosynthesis (3D mammograms) is an innovative new, FDA-approved digital technology that helps physicians detect smaller tumors sooner—at the earliest stages of breast cancer.
